- Ensure hangar facilities are maintained in a tidy and orderly manner. Report on and conduct / facilitate corrective actions of any issues.
- Respond to any administrative requests and / or concerns relating to maintenance equipment and facilities.
- Assist with receipt and dispatching of goods including tooling, bulk shipments, spares and oversize components.
- Improve visibility of all maintenance or facilities related equipment located in the field including quantities, and serviceability status.
